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### SARDAR PATEL UNIVERSITY OF POLICE, SECURITY AND CRIMINAL JUSTICE

Sardar Patel University of Police, Security and Criminal Justice, Jodhpur, was established through an Act of the State Legislature, Government of Rajasthan. ### ABOUT THE CENTRE FOR CHILD PROTECTION

The Centre for Child Protection (CCP) was established by Sardar Patel University of Police, Security and Criminal Justice (SPUP) in 2015 to support a rights-based approach to addressing continuing and emerging challenges affecting children. The Centre works to strengthen preventive and protective child protection mechanisms and systems through academic programmes, capacity building, training, workshops and research.

CCP also supports new initiatives in child protection through networking, coordination and advocacy with relevant departments and stakeholders. As a resource centre on child protection, CCP provides technical support to departments and institutions working to promote and protect the rights of children.

### COURSE OVERVIEW

The Certificate/Diploma Course in Child and Adolescent Counselling is designed to develop professional knowledge, understanding, attitudes and skills in an area of growing social importance. The programme responds to the need for counselling support for children and adolescents, including support that strengthens family relationships, promotes positive parenting and resilience, and addresses socio-psychological concerns and maladaptive behaviours.

The programme emphasises applied learning and hands-on experience. It combines theoretical learning with practical exposure, fieldwork, assignments, demonstrations, workshops and interactive sessions. The programme is intended to prepare participants for professional engagement in child and adolescent counselling and related support services.

The programme follows a 'walkout procedure', under which a participant who completes the first six months and passes the required examination may receive the Certificate in Child and Adolescent Counselling. A participant who completes the full one-year programme and meets the examination requirements may receive the Diploma in Child and Adolescent Counselling.

The following curriculum scheme will be followed:

- **06 months for Certificate Course (One semester of six months).**
- **01 year for Diploma Course (Two semesters - each semester of six months).**

### COURSE OBJECTIVES

- Provide learners with core knowledge required for child counselling.
- Develop understanding of healthy and positive behaviour in children.
- Explain what child counselling is and why it is important.
- Provide hands-on learning in the assessment of childhood and adolescent concerns and in providing appropriate counselling support.
- Equip learners with knowledge of counselling techniques and therapeutic approaches relevant to children and adolescents.
- Provide basic and primary psychological interventions for children, adolescents, families and other stakeholders in the area of child and adolescent wellbeing.
- Strengthen community support systems for addressing psychological concerns among children and adolescents.
- Build capacity through demonstrations, interactive sessions, workshops, field visits and discussions.

## **COURSE 2: CERTIFICATE/DIPLOMA COURSE IN CHILD AND ADOLESCENT COUNSELLING**

### **COURSE OVERVIEW**

Protection of children is a growing concern worldwide. Families, communities, the State and responsible citizens have an important role in preventing harm and safeguarding children's rights. A sound understanding of child protection is essential for creating an environment in which children can grow and enjoy their childhood with dignity.

The Centre for Child Protection, SPUP, in partnership with UNICEF, offers a six-month Certificate Course in Child Protection through distance mode. The course is designed for professionals and other interested candidates who wish to strengthen their knowledge and practice in child protection.

The course is relevant to members of State Juvenile Police Units (SJPU), Juvenile Justice Boards (JJBs), Anti-Human Trafficking Units (AHTUs), Child Welfare Committees (CWCs), Childline services, Child Care Institutions, government and non-government organisations working on child protection and child rights, Panchayati Raj Institutions, students and other persons interested in developing a career or professional engagement in child protection.

The course aims to raise awareness and develop the capacity of persons working or interested in working in the field of child rights to understand, design and implement laws, policies and programmes relating to the protection, development and participation of children.

### **COURSE OBJECTIVES**

- Provide learners with core knowledge of child protection and child rights, including international laws, treaties, frameworks and structures.
- Develop a theoretical understanding of different forms of exploitation against children and their consequences.
- Equip learners with knowledge of child protection laws, policies, services and the roles and responsibilities of different stakeholders.
- Develop an understanding of childhood, related challenges and effective intervention in child protection cases.
- Promote child-friendly approaches and practices among stakeholders.
- Promote proactive investigation strategies and techniques among police officials in the context of child protection.
- Develop capacity to apply a rights-based approach to child welfare and development at field and institutional levels.
- Strengthen coordination and linkages among child protection service providers.
- Develop professionals who can pursue careers in INGOs, NGOs and government agencies working in child protection.

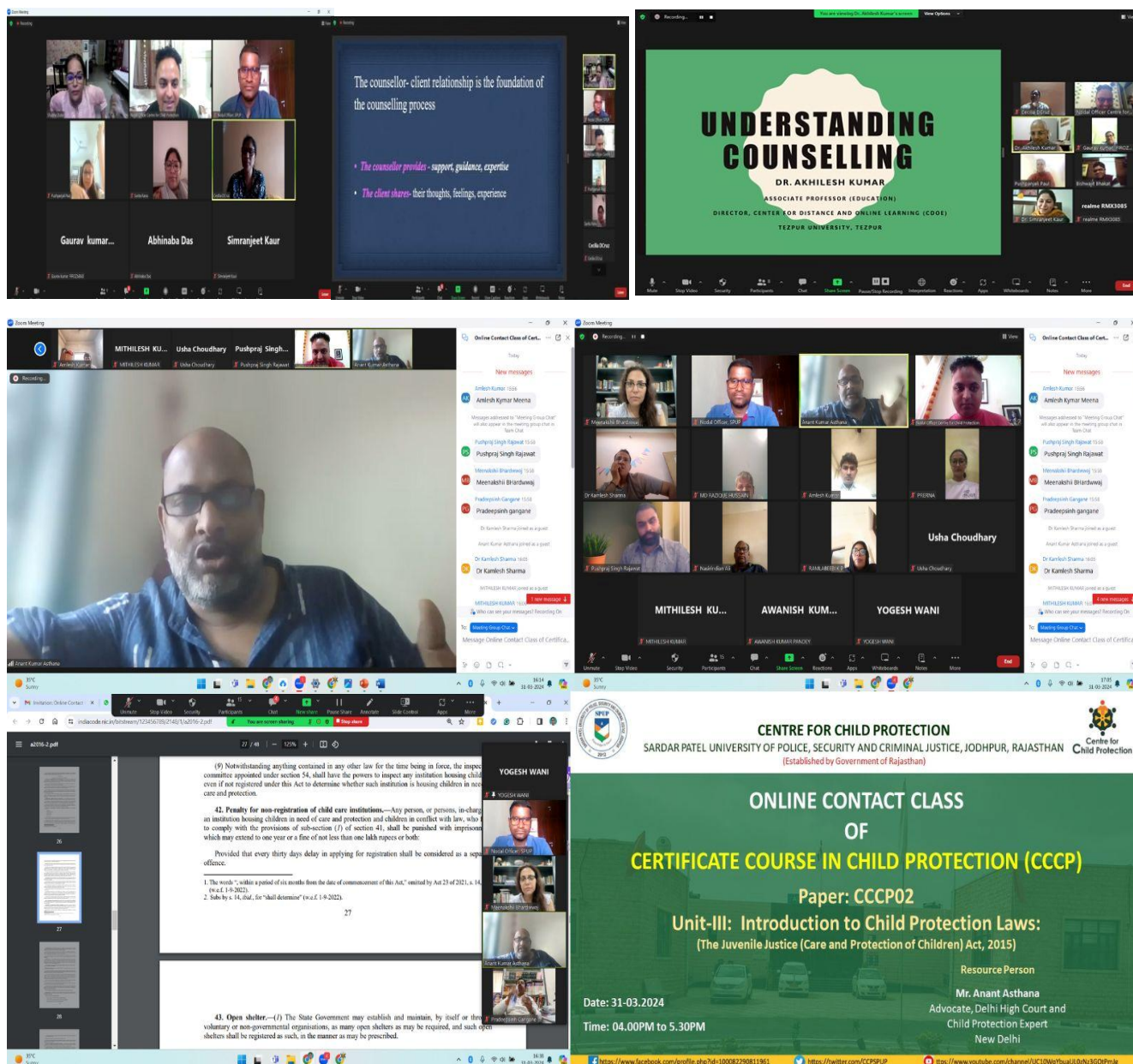
